



Weekend Play Guide (Part-Time, Sat and Sun)

Wonderscope is currently accepting applications from outgoing, high-energy, and detail-oriented individuals to enhance the experience of Wonderscope's weekend guests and members. The ideal candidate enjoys a fast-paced and playful environment, is flexible and able to prioritize tasks spontaneously and independently, and enjoys interacting with children and their adults as they learn, play, and grow.

Duties will include but are not limited to:

1. Going out of your way to create a meaningful experience for members and guests
2. Actively engaging and playing with guests and members in all museum exhibits
3. Addressing visitor questions and concerns with urgency and professionalism
4. Independently facilitating pop-up activities throughout the museum
5. Assisting program staff with additional pop-ups and other programming
6. Ensuring museum floor expectations are met at the highest level, including exhibit restoration and monitoring, weekly/monthly cleaning tasks, and maintaining inviting and safe exhibit spaces
7. Performing exhibit opening, closing, and midday checkup procedures
8. Assisting with birthday parties, including sign-in, payments, and assisting party guests as needed
9. Assisting Welcome Desk as needed, including lunchtime coverage and additional POS assistance
10. Supporting and guiding volunteers on the museum floor
11. Communicating exhibit/facility maintenance needs to Weekend Supervisor
12. Performing other tasks as assigned by Weekend Supervisor

Required Skills:

1. Must be 18 years of age
2. Post-secondary education preferred
3. Commitment to excellence in customer service and teamwork
4. Experience engaging and interacting with young learners and their adults
5. High comfort level working with children in a fast-paced, high-traffic, public environment
6. Views children as capable and competent and recognizes that children learn naturally through play
7. Ability to genuinely communicate with diverse guests of all backgrounds and abilities
8. Ability to respond to guest needs and urgent/emergency situations in a calm, comforting manner
9. Ability to independently manage and prioritize several tasks efficiently and with ease
10. Reliable, flexible, and able to work cooperatively with other staff members as a positive team player
11. A strong commitment to the mission, vision, and values of WCM

Essential Physical Functions: On any given day, may be frequently required to do one or more of the following: climbing, stooping, kneeling, crouching, crawling, reaching, lifting up to 25 pounds and moving short distances
